Thirty people committed to meet in groups of three (in some cases four) ten times over the months of February, March, April and May to pray together. We will pray out loud for each of us as individuals, for our church, for our community, nation, and world. Most **“TRIPLETS”** will have met several times by the time you read this. The feedback we have received, so far, is positive and the experience has been stimulating for those individuals participating.
